

Dr. Tisha Wiley—NIDA

Episode Overview

This episode includes an interview with Dr. Tisha Wiley, Branch Chief, SRB; associate director for justice systems at the National Institute on Drug Abuse (NIDA). Dr. Wiley is the architect and lead of the Justice Community Opioid Innovation Network (JCOIN).



- **JCOIN** is a national research network that seeks evidence-based solutions to issues faced by individuals, families, and communities affected by the opioid epidemic.
- As part of JCOIN, the Learning Experiences to Advance Practice (**LEAP**) program consists of three educational tracks: **LEAP Learners** (e-learning courses and the podcast *Aced It: Turning Science into Sense*), **LEAP Scholars**, and **LEAP Investigators** (these are application-based cohorts for individuals wanting to learn more about the intersection of health and justice and to explore their role as research partners or researchers).
